PEALING THE LAW IN RELATION THERETO.

B E I T E N A C T E D

BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED.

Sec.1 That the office of Superintendent of Schools is hereby abolished, and all that portion of Chapter 1, Sec.1, page 298 of Durant's Code, refering to the board of Education be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec.2 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that all acts or parts of acts and acts amendatory and resolutions relating thereto are hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

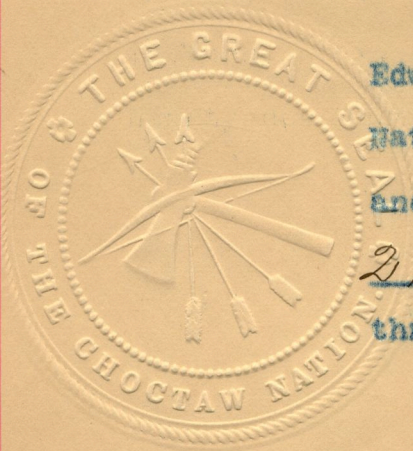
