the said Committee.

Dec 2nd Be it further resolved,
That the Clerk of said
Committee on Chief's Message shall
receive for his services the sum of
Four Dollars (\$4.00) per day, that the
National Auditor shall issue his Warrant
for actual services, and the
National Treasurer shall pay the same.
And this resolution shall take effect
and be in force from and after
its passage and approval.
