

We Your Finance Committee, to whom was referred the account of T. D. Hibben Supreme Clerk of the Choctaw Nation for Twenty(\$25<sup>xx</sup>) dollars for expenses incurred by him in furnishing stationery for the office, and the safe keeping of the books, papers and seal for the last three years would respectfully say that we have carefully examined said account and find that said T. D. Hibben is entitled to the sum of Twenty five(\$25<sup>xx</sup>) dollars, and therefore recommend the passage of the following act: Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled:

Sec 1 That the sum of Twenty five(\$25<sup>xx</sup>) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay T. D. Hibben for expenses incurred in furnishing stationery for the office, and the safe keeping of the books, papers and seal for the last three years.

Sec 2 Be it further enacted: That the National auditor is hereby

authorized to issue his warrant  
and the National Treasurer to pay  
the same;

And this act shall take effect and  
be in force from and after its  
passage. and approval.
