TO THE HONORABLE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE SENATE AND TO THE HONORABLE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, IN SESSION AT TUSKAHOMA:

Comes now your petitioner, Louis C. Leflore, for himself and for Abbot Leflore and for Felicie Landers, now Felicie Goddard and for Rosa, Michael and Josephine Leflore, the last three being the children of your petitioner herein, and respectfully sheweth that they are citizens of the Choctaw Nation or Tribe of Indians by blood and duly enrolled by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes; that their names appear upon the rolls prepared by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes opposite the following numbers, which is their roll number as fixed by said Commission, to-wit;

Further your petitioner sheweth that they were, by Act of this Honorable Council of October, 13, 1893, recognized as citizens of the Choctaw Nation and entitled to all the rights, privileges, and immunities of citizens of said Nation, which said Act of this Council is in words and figures as follows, to-wit;

" AN ACT conferring citizenship on certain persons named.



Be it enacted by the general council of the Choctaw Nation assembled: That Abbot Leflore, Felicie Landers, Louis C. Leflore, and his three children, Rosa, Michael and Josephine, all late of Mississippi, are hereby recognized as citizens of the Choctaw Nation, and entitled to all the rights, privileges, and immunities of citizens of this Nation, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved, October 13, 1893.
