

Whereas, under the Act adopting the Freedmen of the Choctaw Nation enacted in May 1883, Eighty three of said freedmen registered for per-Capita payment. Therefore Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled that the President of the United States or other proper Officer thereof, be and he is hereby requested and directed to turn over as soon as practicable to the Treasurer of the Choctaw Nation the sum of (\$8300.⁰⁰/₁₀₀) Eight thousand three hundred dollars out of the funds set apart under the 3rd Art. of the Treaty of 1866, as provided in the Indian Appropriation bill of March 1883, to pay such freedmen as have elected to remove and who do actually remove from said Nation, the per Capita allowance provided for them by the Treaty of 1866 and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
