WHEREAS, the Principal Chief has been duly advised by the Hon.Secretary of the Interior to the effect that the acts of the last
General Council of the Choctaw Nation, Bill No.4, making an appropriation in the sum of Fifty-four thousand, eight hundred thirtysix dollars and eighty cents to defray the regular and necessar
expenses of the Choctaw Government for the fiscaeal year ARKEX
ending September 30th, 1907, has been disapproved by the President;
and,

WHEREAS, said disapproval is based upon certain items which the Department holds objectionable upon the theory that the county and district officers of the Choctaw Nation have performed no service therefor; and,

WHEREAS, the Department has been misinformed as to service rendered by county and district officers; and,

WHEREAS, we believe that the said officers are lawfully entitled to compensation for services rende red up to February 1,1907; therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION
IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ASSEMBLED:

That the following sums of money are hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Choctaw Nation, as provided in section 11 of an act of Congress approved April 26,1906, to defray the regular and necessary expenses of the Choctaw government commencing Oct., 1,1906, and ending September 30th, 1907, being an act to provide for the final disposition of the affairs of the Five Civilized Tribes of the Indian Territory, and for other purposes:
