AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF

H.P. Hard, County judge, Atoka Co.

WHEREAS, a National Warrant heretofore issued on ~~October 1,~~ <sup>July 2</sup> 1906, <sup>no.</sup> ~~to H.P. Hard, County judge, of said Co.~~ <sup>April</sup>, for salary from ~~July~~ 1, 1906, to ~~September~~ <sup>June</sup> 30th, 1906, No. 203 C \$62.53 and,

WHEREAS, said warrant has been lost or misplaced and after diligent search can not be found;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED IN EXTRAORDEINARY SESSION:

That the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue a duplicate warrant to said H.P. Hard, covering this amount, and that the same shall be paid as provided in an act of Congress approved April 26, 1906, section 11, being an Act to provide for the final disposition of affairs of the Five Civilized Tribes in the Indian Territory, and for other purposes.

That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and approval by the President.
