That the following sums of money ix hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Choctaw Nation, as provided in section 11 of an Act of Congress approved April 26,1906, to defray the regular and necessary expenses of the Choctaw government commencing Oct., 1,1906, and ending September 30th 1907, being an Act to provide for the final disposition of the affairs of the Five Civilized Tribes of the Indian Territory, and for other purposes:
