

BILL NO. 8.

AN ACT for the relief of Dan Folsom.

We, your Finance Committee, to whom was referred the claim of Dan Folsom, captain of the National Lighthorsemen, for services rendered as such lighthorseman in attendance at the special session of the Choctaw Council held in February 1907, do find, after an investigation, that the amount due him for two days' services during said special session of the Council in February 1907, was by an oversight left out of the act making appropriation to defray the expenses of said special session of the Council.

We, therefore, recommend that the Council appropriate the sum of seven dollars (\$7.00) in full payment of said services. Therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED:

That the sum of seven dollars (\$7.00) is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Choctaw Nation, and shall be paid as provided in section 11 of the Act of Congress approved April 26, 1906, entitled "An Act to provide for the final disposition of the affairs of the Five Civilized Tribes, and for other purposes"; said sum being in full payment to the captain of the National Lighthorsemen for the two days services rendered at the special session of the Choctaw Council in February 1907.

That this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
