GENERAL APPROPRIATION BILL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED:

That the following sums of money are hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Choctaw Nation, and shall be paid as provided in section 11 of the Act of Congress approved April 26, 1906, entitled "An Act to provide for the final disposition of the affairs of the Five Civilized Tribes, and for other purposes", said sums to defray the regular and necessary expenses of the Choctaw Government for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 1907, and ending September 30, 1908:

Expenses Delegate to Washington	1,000.00
Expenses General Council	2,601.40

That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
