Referring to the two Acts of the Choctaw Council passed at the October session, 1909, one disallowing the claim of Messrs. L. Silverman & Bro. to be paid the sum of \$75.85 for county scrip of Cedar County and the other disallowing the claim of C. L. Joyce to be paid the sum of \$122.30 for county scrip of Blue County, you are advised that the Department held that these Acts did not require Executive action.

The scrip referred to has been filed in the office of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.
