

Approved, date as of October 1, 1907. According to the terms thereof; Therefore, "Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled:

Sec 1. That the sum of Five thousand dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Choctaw Nation, and shall be paid as provided in Section 11 of the Act of Congress approved April 26, 1906. Entitled an Act to provide for the final disposition of the Affairs of the "Five Civilized Tribes", and for other purposes, to the said McIntain and Hill in accordance with the terms of said Contract.

Sec 2. That the further sum in an amount sufficient to pay the expenses of the said McIntain and Hill under said Contract is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Choctaw Nation, and shall be paid in like manner as provided in Section 11 of said Act of Congress approved April 26, 1906.

That this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

"An Act providing for the Compensation and Expenses of M<sup>c</sup>Cartain<sup>d</sup> and Hill as General Counsel of the Choctaw Nation employed under Section 28 of the Act of Congress Approved April 26, 1906."

Whereas, on the thirty first day of August, Nineteen Hundred and seven the Principal Chief entered into a Contract with M<sup>c</sup>Cartain and Hill, Subject to the approval of the President of the United States, Employing them as general Counsel for the Choctaw Nation<sup>d</sup>, Whereas, under the terms of said Contract, M<sup>c</sup>Cartain and Hill are to receive a Compensation of Five thousand Dollars, per annum for their services, and such expense as are incurred in the discharge of their duty under said employment, such as traveling expenses, board and subsistence while away from M<sup>c</sup>Alister D. T., including clerical assistance, to be paid by the United States Indian Agent, upon accounts submitted with accompanying vouchers to be approved by the Secretary of the Interior or under his direction, and Whereas, said Contract is now pending before the President for approval and will when
