

A Resolution

Asking that information be furnished the
tribes respecting the collection of coal and
asphalt-royalties and the disbursement of the
same for school purposes.

Whereas, There is a general desire among the
citizens of the Choctaw Nation for in-
formation relative to the amount of coal
and asphalt-royalty collections, and the
disbursement of the same for school pur-
poses; Therefore,

Be it resolved by the General Council
of the Choctaw Nation assembled; That the
Hon Secretary of the Interior be and he
hereby is respectfully requested to direct the
proper local officers of the Interior Depart-
ment to furnish the Principal Chief
with a statement showing the amount
of coal and asphalt-royalties collected
and placed to the credit of the tribe, the
amount expended for school purposes
and the balance remaining to the
credit of the tribe.

Be it further resolved; That the
Hon. Secretary be respectfully requested to
direct the proper school authorities to

furnish the Principal Chief with a statement - showing the number of tribal schools now being maintained wholly or in part - from the Choctaw tribal funds, such statement - to show the amount - paid the teachers and employes in each of the respective tribal schools and the number of Choctaw children at - attendance at each of said schools.

That this resolution take effect - and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
