

Received Doaksville Choctaw Nation June 12th A.D. 1861 of Major P.P. Pitchlynn, Israel Folsom, and Peter Folsom, a Treasury Draft of the United States Payable at sight for the sum of One Hundred and Twelve thousand dollars No. 2879 issues on the requisition of the Department of the Interior No. 4069 signed by _____ Spinner Treasurer of the United States, drawn on assistant Treasurer U.S. New York, registered by F. Bings of the Treasury dated April 13th 1861--it being a part payment made by the Government of the United States, on the appropriation of Five Hundred thousand Dollars as an advancement on the award allowed under the _____ 12th article of the Treaty of June 22 1855--which sum (\$112,000.00) when collected, it is hereby agreed to, and understood that one half of the amount shall be paid over to the said P.P. Pitchlynn, Israel Folsom, Peter Folsom and Samuel Garland jointly for fees due them according to certain contract entered into in conformity with the acts and resolution of the Choctaw Nation in council assembled, after deducting such charges which may be incurred in negotiating the draft, and in the transportation of the same, if in specie &c.--
