

An act constraining the treaty of 1866  
in reference to Missionaries.

Be it enacted by the General Council of  
the Choctaw Nation assembled, that, the  
scheme of changing the tenure of lands  
by the Choctaws and Chickasaws, as inaugu-  
rated by the 11<sup>th</sup> article of the treaty of  
1866 having failed; all of the conditions  
and contingencies connected with, and  
dependent upon that change also failed;  
that, those ~~articles~~<sup>all of published</sup> articles of said treaty contain-  
ing such a change are void, and Mission-  
aries or any other class of persons mentioned  
therein, have no rights thereunder, and  
this act shall take effect and be in  
force from and after its passage.
