

Bill No 27 Continued,

Payment to be made in the manner herein after provided.

Sec. 2 Itemized accounts thereof shall be presented to the Principal Chief and upon his approval, the National Auditor shall issue his warrant therefor, and the National Treasurer shall pay the same.

Sec. 3rd The Principal Chief is further authorized to direct that such expenses be incurred and such legal services be rendered as in his judgement may be necessary to adequately protect the interests of the Choctaw Nation. In the various matters that may hereafter arise from time to time, itemized accounts therefor shall be presented in like manner, to the Principal Chief to be by him submitted to the next ensuing council and the same shall be paid, not to exceed the sum of Five Thousand dollars, including both fees and expenses, whenever said accounts are approved by the Council.

Sec. 4 The contingent fund of the Principal Chief in addition to that now provided by law is hereby increased sufficient to carry into effect the purpose of this act, to the extent only of services already rendered and expenses incurred and an appropriation therefor is hereby made, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, and all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Bill No 28,

A Resolution accepting the report of J. E. Sanguine collector of the 3rd District of the Choctaw Nation, for the 4th Quarter of the Fiscal Year ended, Sept. 30th 1902

We your Finance committee, to whom was referred the final report of J. E. Sanguine, collector for the 3rd District of the Choctaw Nation, for the 4th Quarter of the fiscal year ended September 30th 1902 have carefully examined the same and find that the total amount of royalty collected for that Quarter to be \$824.51, deducting therefrom 10 per cent, or \$82.45 his commission leaves the balance due the Nation of \$742.06. The receipt of the National Treasury accompanies the report showing that this amount has been paid over by the collector.

The report further indicates that a certain certificate for the sum of \$96.00 had been burned and the collector seeks to reimburse himself by reason of this loss, through aid of Council. Your committee have deemed it proper to disallow said amount and therefore recommend the adoption of the following resolution.

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation in regular session assembled,

Sec 1. That the report of J. E. Sanguine collector for the 3rd District of the Choctaw Nation for the Fourth Quarter of the fiscal year ended September 30th 1902 be and the same is hereby accepted as true and correct.

Sec 2 And that this resolution take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval
