Be it resolved by The General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled.

Sec I That the Chairman of the Committee on petitions shall appoint a Cleric for the said Committee whose duty it shall be to make and keep a full record of the work of said Committee.

Sec II Be it further resolved that the Clerk of said Committee shall receive for his services four dollars \$4.00 per day. That the National Auditor shall issue his warrant for actual services and the National Treasurer shall pay the same.

And this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage & approval.

Resolution =
Requiring the officers of Bedon, Eagle, Washoba, Bostwick & Klamutia Counties to submit their Records for the inspection of the Judiciary Committee.

Whereas, In view of the approach and end of tribal Government, renders it necessary that steps be taken to examine the financial condition of those Counties which are known to be in debt;

And Whereas the Nation must assume such obligations as remain outstanding at the close of tribal Government;

And Whereas this Authority is vested solely in the General Council of the Choctaw Nation.

Therefore Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled.

That the Judiciary Committee is fully empowered with the aid of the Principal Chief to notify the officers of Bedon, Eagle, Washoba, Bostwick & Klamutia Counties to appear before said Judiciary Committee, with the records of their respective Counties for the purpose of answering such questions relative to the financial condition of their respective Counties as may be propounded by the said Judiciary Committee.

Be it further resolved by the Principal Chief that it shall be the duty of the Principal Chief to notify said officers to appear before said Committee not later than 25 days Oct 1905. And that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage & approval.
