Resolution

empowering the Principal Chief to take proper action relative to the re-establishment of the boundary line between the Choctaw Nation and the State of Texas.

Whereas The Original boundary line between the Choctaw Nation and the State of Texas was plainly out lined by Red River; And

Whereas Said Stream has shifted its current to such an extent as to cut off from the public domain of the Choctaw Nation many thousand acres of valuable land belonging to the Choctaw & Chickasaw Nations; And

Whereas it is necessary to Re-establish the original boundary line in order that we may intelligently dispose of these lands by allotment and other wise;

Therefore

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled,

Sec I That the Principal chief of the Choctaw Nation is hereby authorized and empowered to take such action as may be necessary to Re-establish the boundary line between the Choctaw Nation and the State of Texas.

Sec II Be it further resolved that the Principal chief is hereby authorized to take such steps as deemed necessary to secure peaceful possession of said lands and that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

We your Finance Committee to whom was referred the account of J. D. Hibben Supreme Clerk of the Choctaw Nation for Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars for expenses incurred by him in furnishing stationery for the office, and the safe keeping of the books, papers and seal for the last three years would respectfully say that we have carefully examined said account and find that said J. D. Hibben is entitled to the same of Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars, and therefore recommend the passage of the following act;

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled

Sec I That the sum of Twenty five (\$25.00) dollars be and the same is thereby appropriated out of any money in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay J. D. Hibben for expenses incurred in furnishing stationery for the office, and the safe keeping of the books, papers and seal for the last three years.

Sec II Be it further enacted: That the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant and the National Treasurer to pay the same; and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
