

Bill no 4 =

An act for the relief of Robt Harrison County Clerk Atoka County. Whereas, a National Warrant heretofore issued on July 2 1906 to Robt Harrison, Clerk of Said County, For Salary from April 1, 1906, to June 30th 1906, No 203 C \$25.00.

And Whereas, Said warrant has been lost or misplaced and after diligent search can not be found;

Be it Therefore enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled in Extraordinary Session:

That the National Auditor is hereby Authorized to issue a duplicate warrant to Said Robt Harrison, Covering this amount, and the same shall be paid as provided in an act of Congress Approved April 26, 1906, Section 11, being an act to provide for the final disposition of affairs of the five civilized tribes in the Indian Territory, and for other purposes.

That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and approval by the President.

Bill no 6

An act for the relief of H. P. Ward, County Judge Atoka Co.

Whereas, a National warrant, heretofore issued on July 2, 1906 to H. P. Ward, County Judge of Said County for salary from April 1, 1906 to June 30th 1906 No 203 C \$67.50 and

Whereas, Said warrant has been lost or misplaced and after diligent search can not be found.

Be it therefore enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled in Extraordinary Session:

That the National Auditor is hereby Authorized to issue a duplicate warrant to Said H. P. Ward, Covering this amount and that the same shall be paid as provided in an act of Congress Approved April 26, 1906, Section 11, being an act to provide for the final disposition of affairs of the five civilized tribes in the Indian Territory, and for other purposes.

That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and approval by the President.
