



Appellants herein respectfully show that they are of right
citizens of the Choctaw nation and members of the Choctaw tribe of
Indians and entitled to all of the rights, privileges and immunities
of said citizenship and membership, but that their said rights of citi-
zenship and membership are denied by the lawful authorities of the said
Choctaw nation.

That on the 7th day of September, 1896, your petitioners
together with others not named herein, made their application in due
form to the United States Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes com-
monly known as the Dawes Commission, asking that they and each of them
be enrolled by the said commission as members of the Choctaw tribe
of Indians according to law.

That thereafter said application was by said commission re-
fused and denied.

That from the action and decision of said commission in refusing and denying said application your petitioners, with the time prescribed by law and in the manner required by law, appealed from the said decision of said commission to the United States Court for the Central District of the Indian Territory at South McAlester in the Indian Territory.

That said court thereafter rendered judgment upon said appeal affirming the decision of said commission and denying the right of petitioners herein to be enrolled as members of the Choctaw tribe of Indians.

That said cause was upon the citizenship docket of said court numbered 93, and entitled Glenn-Tucker et al., vs. The Choctaw Nation.

The premises considered petitioners respectfully pray an appeal from the judgment of the United States Court for the Central District of the Indian Territory at South McAlester in said cause, and that a writ of error and summons in due form be issued and directed to the Choctaw and Chickasaw nations or tribes of Indians according to law, to the end that said cause may be reviewed in this Honorable Court and that justice may be done petitioners.

And your petitioners will ever pray, etc.
