To Whom these Presents may Come, Greeting :

WHEREAS, has come well recommended by citizens of this Nation, of good standing, as being a person of good moral character, and worthy of having a permit granted.

Therefore, I, PRINCIPAL CHIEF OF THE MUSCOGEE NATION, do by power in me vested by law, grant the said permission to remain in the Muscogee Nation, (..... having married a citizen thereof,) and enjoy all the rights and privileges of a native born citizen, except those rights debarred in law, viz : shall have no right to participate in the moneys, land interests, or vote in this nation. This permit is subject to the approval of the U. S. Indian Agent, the Creeks, and conditioned upon the continued good behavior of the said

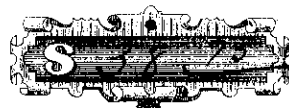

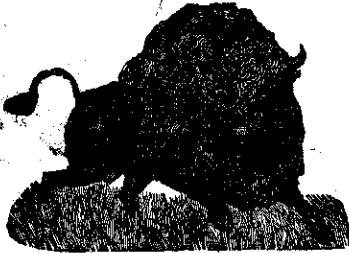

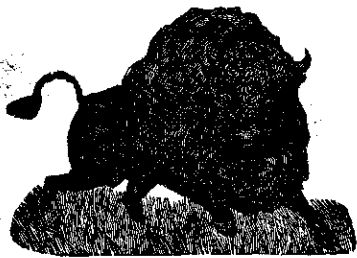
