Dear Sir:

Complaint, ^{in writing} has been submitted to this office by the Hon. S. J. Haynes, Judge of Dist Court of Okmulgee Dist. Muskogee Nation concerning the grazing of foreign cattle in the interior pastures &c. a copy of which you will find enclosed to explain itself, and according to the said Judge's request, I do hereby respectfully ask your honor to give warning to all owners or holders of foreign cattle not to introduce such cattle in ^{to} the Muskogee Nation, for the purpose of grazing them in the said interior pastures or joined one mile square pastures, as such introduction of such cattle for said purpose would be in violation to the laws of this Nation, as well as it would be in violation to the United States, Intercourse laws, of Sec. 2117.
