Dear Judge:

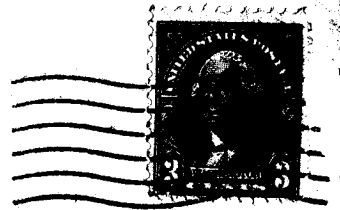
It seems now to be a settled fact that all District WPA offices will be abolished in the State of Oklahoma and in their stead there will be 15 area offices established one of which I hear is to be located in the City of Seminole. These area Offices I am told will carry only a skeleton force of workers and I want to be one of the Skeletons in that office. As you know, probably, I have been employed in this office for nearly 2 years returning to Wewoka each week-end and at all times maintaining my residence there. I have longed to come back and work with my neighbors and friends in whom I am much interested. You will also recall that I worked in the F.E.R.A. Office there under Mrs. Lucille B. Hill in 1934 I believe. This work is very near to my heart. During the time I have been here it has been my good fortune to do Secretarial work in the two projects Sponsored by the State Department of Public Health, namely: Malaria Control and Community Sanitation which deal with the lives of men and women in the institution of Health measures in the elimination of disease.

Not knowing what the new Set-up will consist of I do not know what to ask for. Because of my mature age and past experience as a School Teacher, wife, mother and secretary I feel that I have executive ability also and with my 3 years experience in this work I feel that I could fill with justice and dignity any office that may be open in a manner that the citizenship of my County will never have cause to regret but that will point to with pride in the future. I am told that in the new set-up persons will be allowed to either work in their own County if not chosen for the Oklahoma City Office and I prefer to work at Seminole if possible.

We have had no definite Official instructions in this however, I am sure it is coming as is everyone connected here and of course you know that such work as this we are never given instructions in advance any A.M. we are expecting to have orders to button up and come Home hence I write you knowing that you will have first hand information and probably will be asked for recommendations.
