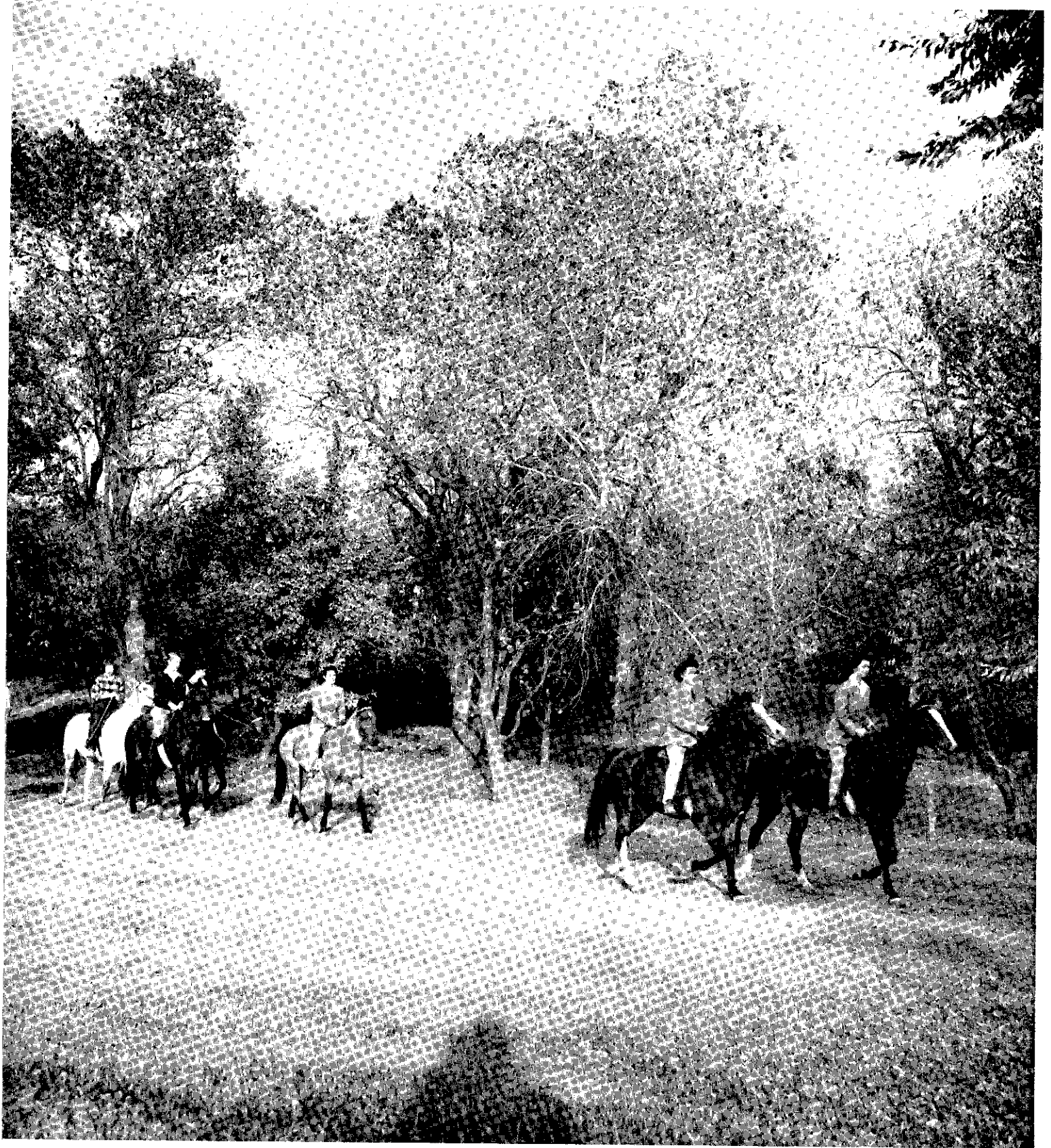

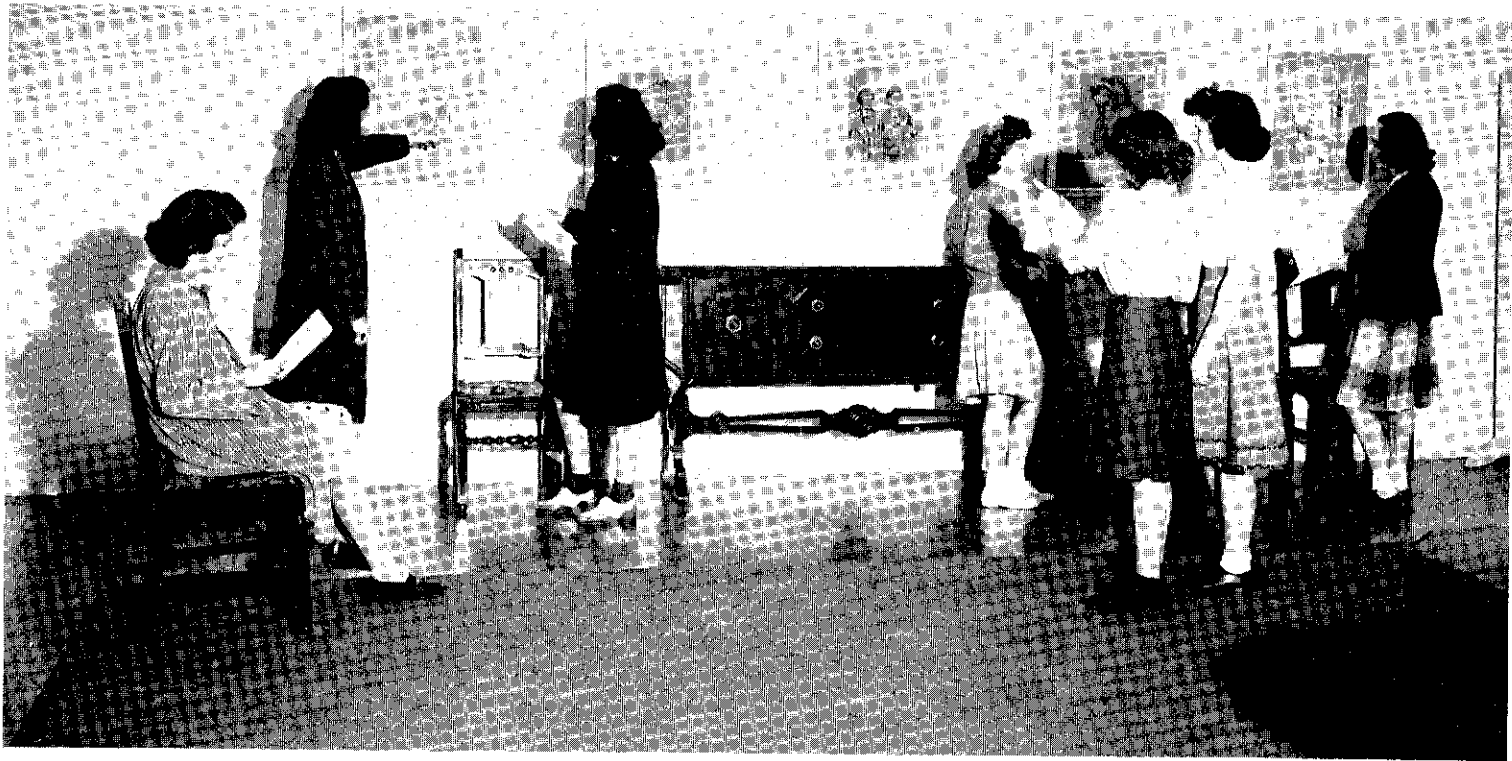

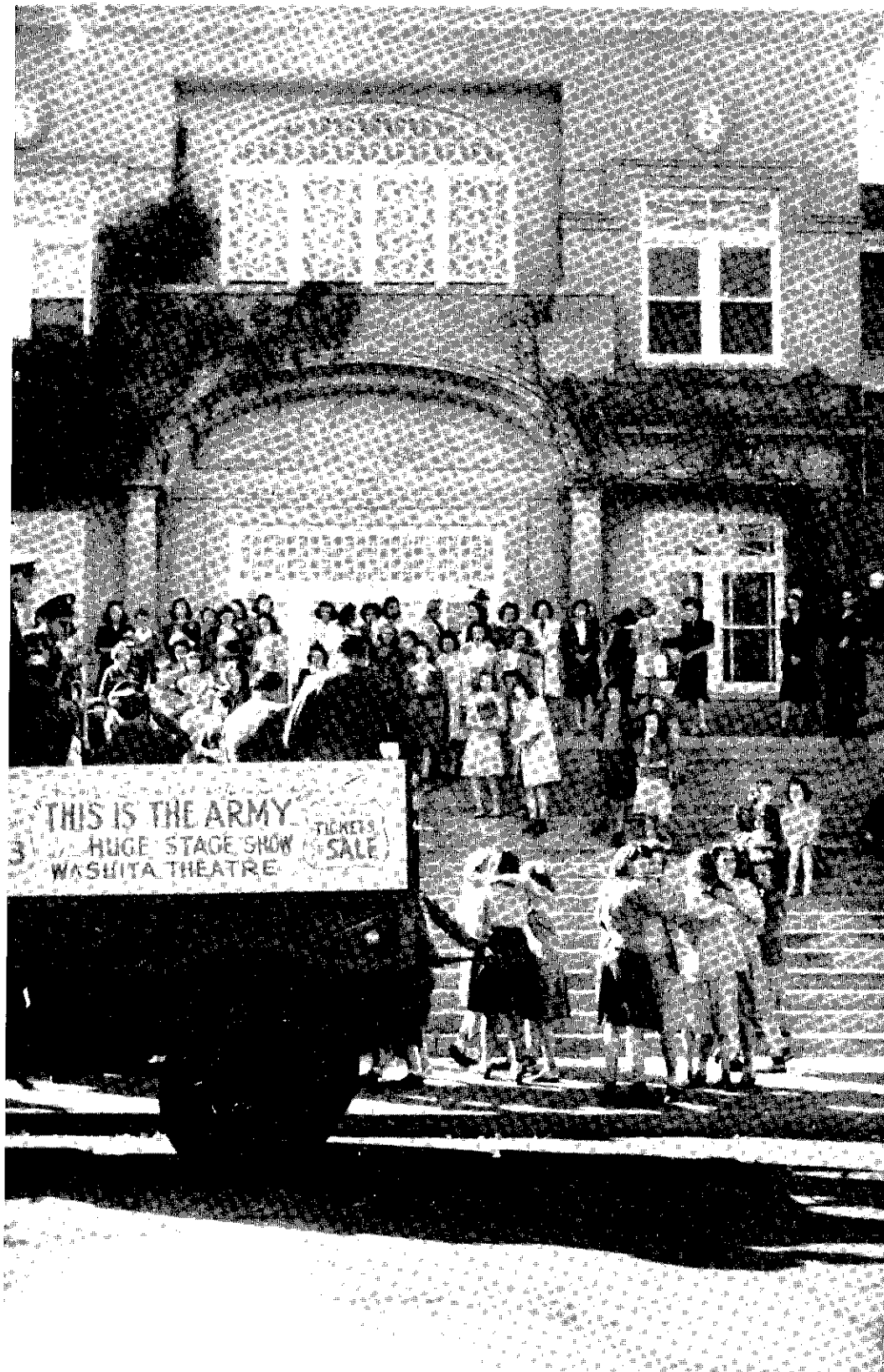
# THE COLLEGE SHOP
