He was wounded at
Pilot Knob Mo in
Price's raid. He was
captured there carried
to Alton Ill and held
as a prisoner until
peace was declared.

Your great grand father
was ~~born~~ born in Tenn moved
to Johnson Co Ark with
his family. Family con-
sisted of five boys and
two girls. H. H. Butts,
J. J. Butts, L. H. Butts
W. J. Butts, Nathaniel
Butts. Phemelia and
Addeline Butts - His

occupation was a teacher
 and then a physician.
 Your great grandfather,
