

(But you don't think classes or education will help any?)

No, I don't think so. For the best educated Indian people there is, drinks. Some of them got to be alcoholics. So, that's the reason I don't think education will help them, from being alcoholic too much.

(Do you think a lot of the time, it's the pressures of living in this day and age? And then they're not quite ready. Okay. We do have all of the job training and everything now, but we have only had this for a few years. We have not brought them up to level of what white people expect from everybody that is out in the competitive society, has to compete for a job. In other-words, I don't think that the Indian people are up that far. Do you think-- am I right in thinking this? And do you think that this might have something to do with why they consume so much alcohol?)

Yes it is. I think that you are right on that.

(And they feel tense about it--they know they can't compete.)

I know it. I think that there are a lot of them that have that kind of feeling, (They feel that, well, it's no good, no use for me to go over there, I can't get a job.)

Just like, I heard a story yesterday. An Indian man was telling me about it. A man been sick for a long time, so he didn't know what to do. Said the first doctor he went to for check-up, doctor told him, said now, said the only thing I can tell you to do is--
