

that these Intern doctors also need to practice but we feel like that we should have a skilled doctor to assist these Intern doctors who needs some practice to go out into the world to protect our people who are ill in the near future.

EDUCATION - NEED OF TEACHERS WHO SPEAK BOTH LANGUAGES

Secondly is education. We need a qualified teachers Aid to assist these un-speaking English students that are starting out, first three years I would say would be necessary to have a Teachers Aid that speaks both languages--Cherokee and English.

WELFARE PROBLEMS ARE MANY

Third--is the Welfare system, back in early thirties, we voted on Welfare Assistance (for the Old Age Assistance) When they became 65 years of age the "New Deal" brought in welfare system providing that when they became 65 years of age they would automatically be brought to assist them on their Old Age Assistance. And at that election, I'll, if I remember correctly, there was nothing that was brought about that these Indians must sell their lands before they could be on the Old Age Assistance or even on the other assistance and today we have a different types of welfare systems such as O.I.O., O.E.O., County Welfare and these types of assistance. We now have some people who are needing assistance who have been put on the run, from one department to the other: And finally they appear at the O.C.C.O. office, wondering where to start, who to depend on for their assistance who are in need of assistance. Some are under doctors care unable to be assisted by these departments, and we also try to help those unable to solve their assistance. And we have also out-patients who are transferred from these various local hospitals and even as far as out of state. We transfer some patients to Oklahoma City, some to hospitals at Tulsa and some to Tahleahina and some patients have to go to a
