

They went down there. They were on the warpath even though they were on the reservation. They came over there and surround the mountain, and killed some of them and run them out, and left lot of Indian horses there. So they got the horses back and chased the Navajo's way back to wherever they came from. So since then, I believe it was almost ninety years ago, and since then, they hadn't seen any Navajo around here. Until today, our schools are full of Navajo's well just that to say about the Navajo that's why that little mountain back there is known as Navajo Mountain to the Comanche Indian. And I think this little creek they call it Elm Creek, Comanches' do, but I don't know what the white man calls it. It runs and joins Red River. So, my people are today, don't have today's generation I mean, got no, most of them don't know that, and they got no hostile feeling against the Navajo. But they always say they were their enemies, always fought them when they come around. As far as they, I could hear about, they always go cross the Red River and way down to Rio Grande, to raid. And the New Mexico people are use to them and they let them pass, and they don't bother them. Well they would go way up north into almost Canada. And there is a line said by the Comanches that you never cross the line over east, where the four civilized tribes live. Only when they come around to the country they are fighting and I have heard over a hundred years ago, my people have gone way into the coast. A few of them is on the war path, and they find some Indians way up in southern California, who talks just like us, and we don't know what they tribal name is, but they're there so that is the way it is, we almost run the central section of the United States. An today my people, for instance, like I feel today, I live in a apartment for a time, and it's just like squeezing you. LThat's the way it feels today, we got a small part of the whole land we use to roam. And now today I'm glad I live with the people that came across the big, big sea. Many times I thought I don't like it, in time you have to like something, so, lately there is some people mypeople who don't understand atill, tellme, "You can't be white your black." And says you don't know how to live like a white
