Yeah, my folks was. Yeah. I was born after Statehood. 1910. (Yeah, so there's a possibility it could have been Rogers?) Yeah. (Well, now Chief Keeler's been in now for about fifteen or twenty years, hasn't he?) Something like that, about twenty years I gues's. (Uh-hun. Well as far as the Cherokee tribe is concerned, have you, do you think there's been an improvement or can you see anything that is happening?) A gain, anything like that? (Yeah, some gains that you've achieved?) If we don't do anything, we're going to lose out. I believe that's right. (You think that it could be better, in other words?) It could be better. (Un-huh) If we work at it. It could get better yet. (Well, that's good. Now do you all elect your chief or --?) No. (How is that determined?) They've--these--all the chiefs that I know of have been appointed. Over yonder. (You mean Washington?) Washington, Yeah. (Uh-huh) The Bureau of Indian Affairs they're called. (I see.) Some place up there. We don't know anything about it. We don't know what goes on. I don't know what happens if (not clear) died out. Then Marlin(?) took it over.
