Yeah. It would, maybe it'll help, you know later but I don't think it'll help too much.

(Well I heard that they're putting in a little company, some kind of a fabric company, to make seat covers. Have you heard anything about that?)

Oh, where are they putting that in?

(I believe it's out there on the same location-- the same site.)

Probably have, but I don't recall right now what it was.

(I think it's Bates Fabric Company. Bates.)

I don't remember reading anything about that. But if they say they're going to hire Indians before, they'll probably hire a few and the others will be white. That's the way, you know, most of these organizations have been doing.

(So you think the jobs kinda go according to the color of your skin, huh?)

Probably. But I think it would work, you know if the whites would stay in there to train these and after they're trained well they would get out and let them take over.

(Un-huh)
