name, but they still worship the same God. And I believe these tribes, at one time, was one, because their customs and their language was too much alike that they could be four or five separate, distinct tribes.

(Are there any Peorias who are still living on their allotments?)

No. I mentioned before where they had sold most of their land. The only one that I can recall that kept her allotment until her death was Stella Sky

LaFallier. Now she received allotment and she still had it when she passed away, about two or three years ago. but all the rest, as far as I know, have been sold.
