(Participant, lady:) It wouldn't cost him anymore to get a new propane than to use his old one.

Mr. Clement: No, because monthly payments. He's going to pay for the utilities and then he's going to pay the rent.

(Participant, man:) When you should suggest to him, what we should suggest then to him to do, if he has a propane tank out there, that he uh, course he's got a stove along with it. And we're going to furnish the stove but he
