Little old rock church in the middle of Pawhuska. It's been gone long ago. It was a small church. It was Catholic. That was my husband's religion. They used to be very religious. Marcene was the only one that joined the Catholic church of my children. I believe Sonny, I don't know, he might have joined it at Newkirk where he was married. He used to talk about it, the Catholic religion.
