Concho near El Reno, Riverside in Anadarko, Fort Sill in Lawton, Carter Seminary in Ardmore, Jones Academy nearby Hartshorne, Eufaula in Eufaula, Sequoyah nearby Tahlequah, Seneca nearby Wyandotte and Chilocco nearby Oklahoma and Arkansas City, Kansas, these schools being located throughout Oklahoma to serve the area most populated by Indians; and Whereas, Chilocco (words inaudible) of Oklahoma is located on the extreme north central corner of Oklahoma; (words not clear) students from any (word not clear) in the United States (words not clear) Oklahoma enroll Indian students (words not clear) grades from one to ten. In other words, there are over a thousand students there and only one hundred from Oklahoma; and that these non-Oklahoma students in most cases receive priority for enrollment through recommendation by social service agencies, because of social and economic conditions at home. And with this (words not clear) conditions the present school administration (words inaudible) personnel to assist in (words inaudible); and (words not clear) be operated exclusively and strictly as very (words not clear) as a vocational technical school for non-graduate, seventeen and a half years of age or older, and post-graduate high school students, who may or may not be married. And that this diversified vocational technical facility be fully utilized (words not clear) for purposes of offering remedial courses and teaching skills and vocation which will serve the needs of industry and potential employers of this region. That the appropriate funds of tuition and other services which are available now be used to receive training in
