other vocational technical training institutions be diverted to sot the (words inaudible) funds to supplement the present operating funds for Chiloccos and that these funds for seven institutions be administered for purposes of staff facilities with a trained and capable faculty who heve proven in the field of vochtional technical education, And (words inaudible) that this employment assistance area rolocation of the Bureau of Indian Affairs be utilized to coordinate their offorts and concentrate on aployient and placement of all those students who satisfactorily complete the requirements for the course. (words not clear). And Be It Further Resolvod; "That BIA' oparated schools in Oklahoma' (words inaudible) Chilocco be operated as (nords not clear) schools for the Indian students of Oklahoma; that whatever (words not clear) these schools shall reap the benefit of the junior and senior high school grades on a dormitory residence basis, whereby studentes shall attend public schools and be given the opportunity and encouragement to participate in local and community activities. And now Be It Resolved, That the approach of meaningful purpose of this resolution is (words not clear) recomendation and assinilation of the Indian boarding schools' duties and the technical training centers to $\backslash$ enter in the 皿instream of our young Indian society and to contribute to the upgrading and improvenent of existing educational facil itios which hopafully in turn will produce trained, skilled and employable craftsmen; and thersby these pertons can becone responsible and active citizens of thoir community."
