Yeah--

(I've got this Amy Nash on here, but did you father have any more children by any other wife?)

No. Oh, this woman he was living with--her name was Bessie Big Head. And he had a boy--Roy Bad Man. And I don't know just what got wrong with him. He died in Okeene..

(Now did your father have any other children besides Roy?)

No. After Roy, that's when he died. Weah, because Roy was still here when he died. And then he got hurt, somehow and they took him to Okeene and he died over there.

(How old was he?)

He must have been about eleven when he died.

(Did your mother and father separate before she died, or were they still married--?)

They were together when she died. And my grandmother used to have a tipi for him right on the side of her tipi, and my father used to stay there, and that Samuel, when he was a little baby. That's where they used to stay.

(Wa/s that next to Punkin?).

Yeah. My grandmother, Punkin.

(Well, after your mother died, did you father still stay there or did he move somewhere else?)

He stayed there. He had tipi there and he stayed there. Then, you know, these Indians, they start selling their land. He sold his land and he just went wild. Yeah, but he was getting old then. He got to where he was drinking and he was buying horses and stuff like that, and he gave them to us. And finally, when my brother died, I gave them horses away. My grandmother tole me to do that—to give them away.

(When you were little, did you ever live around your father's sister or
