BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Polly Cochran Blackfox is seventy-three years old. She was born and raised in this same area of Oaks, Oklahoma where she lives at the present time. Her husband, John Blackfox is a well-known Indian doctor among the Cherokees in this part of Oklahoma. Aunt Polly, as she is known here, speaks very little English. She is a full-blood Cherokee.

INTERVIEW SITUATION: Mrs. Blackfox does not speak English in this interview, so a relative, Maggie Downing is translating as Mrs. Blackfox is speaking. Parts of this interview were difficult to hear due to background noise, children, television, etc.
