we'd go in and ask for a certain amount that we needed. Then, after it was give to as, it went for about three months before we got our headrights. And after we got our headrights, we went in and settled up our accounts, which we had made at the Wewoka Trading Company, and that continued for many years with these coupons, which were a great help to us during our lifetime.

MEKUSUKEY SCHOOL FACULTY AND STAFF:

During first time they took me to school, we left Wewoka in a wagon, proceeded on to, at that time it was Tidmore, Oklahoma. It is now known as Seminole, Oklahoma. And then from there to Mekusukey Mission, where I attended school. The year that I first started school I do not know. When I arrived at school, these are the faculty of the school, as I remember: Miss Dennison was a cook; Mr. Coker was superintendent: Mr. Harden was principal; Miss Jennings was a teacher and Mr. Jennings was agricultural teacher.

INTRODUCTION TO "THE WORD OF GOD":

And also, too, that I remember a lady by the name of Diamond and also had a mother there. Now those two are the ones that I would say were the first white people that ever introduced us to the Word of God, or they, course they taught us how to pray, and showed us what that book was which they were holding was a Bible in their hand. And that was the first time that I ever had any connection or had the mention the word God during my lifetime up until then.
