(Yeah.)

Cemetery there. That's where he's buried. We went to the funeral when we heard about him passing away.

(Static.)

MOODY WAS AN ACTIVE PLACE IN EARLY DAYS

(Now Moody used to be quite a little place I guess at one time from what I've heard.Didn't they used to have a mill up here?)

A mill?

(Uh-huh. Or cotton gin or something at one time?)

You mean around Moody? There used to be a sawmill and cotton gin.

(Saw mill. Yeah.)

Store.

(Hmm)

And Moody Springs is north of the store down here. It's north of that.

(Well.)

'Bout half a mile. Yeah, that creek, that's an old timer. That's on the Fourteen Mile Creek.

(Well)

When you go through Hulbert on that second creek you cross, you see the sign on the bridge.

(Yeah.)

And right here is the head of this Fourteen Mile Creek.

(Well, this is one of the old communities of the Cherokee Nation, isn't it?)

(Who was the old man Indian that they call Moody? Did you ever hear?)

Daddy used to say -- He lived up there where the spring is and that spring

took the name of it. My dad used to say /-- (Static)
