Well and I have to work, and that boy likes it. (Did you have any favorite programs that you like the best?) I don't know, I ain't got time to watch it. (Laughter). (To figure it out, huh?) Yeah. (Laughter) (Maggie and Aunt Suzie speak in Indian language for about a minute. Also Field Worker and Maggie discussing husband's health.) Sometimes, it hurts him pretty bad (inaudible), you know. (Are you diabetic?) Maggie: Huh-uh. (Is Aunt Suzie?) Maggie: I hope I don't take that. I reckon. My doctor never did say nothing about it. (Uh-huh. Well, that's good.) Well, they did say one time. He said that, "You're doing pretty good. You need--you didn't take any like that yet." I said, "Did they catch (?) like that?" (Laughter) Doctor said, "No." He said, "Why?" I said, "I was wondering (?) so many people like that." (Laughter) (Well, now when you was in the hospital, you were in for -- you were hemorrhaging. Is that your stomach or --?) Yeah, never did find out what the cause of it. Maggie: Don't you think about that stuff we had like this? Don't you think come up on her? (Her stomach?) Maggie: Uh-huh. (It might be something like that.) Maggie: You know, I can smell blood sometime, you know, even then. (Inaudible) like that. (Inaudible) he had a, oh, (speaks in Indian

language.)
