Uh-huh, you've got these other big barn owls. . . generally any owl to the Kiowa's is a bad omen.

(Uh-huh.)

In fact, my Mom, my Grandmother wouldn't think of having something like that in their house. (Not clear).

(I've explained to two or three, I've had to explain to two or three Indians that it was perfectly alright, because it wasn't that type of an owl but the Indian people who know about medicine and doctoring they know when they look at that owl that it's not that kind of an owl. But of course all Indians don't know all that, you know. The ones that I think it has scared I explain that it's to protect me and to scare away the evil spirits.)

So, that's your protection?

(Yes, well, Don, thank you very much, "WY-Dough".)

O.K. I've got to go anyway.
