Question is, what was the curriculum in the Seminaries? I think that the curriculum was not so much different than it is now except it is a little more flourished. In other words, they had reading, they had math, complete, in addition to that they had such courses as personal hygiene. Personal hygiene there was not necessarily brushing teeth or anything, but personal grobming, fact is, the pictures I've seen, on Saturdays, the girls would dress up, floor length white gowns, little white bonnets on their heads, this was part of their grooming from Mount Hollium College in Massachusetts. The very influencial girls school, and they taught the girls how to dress, how to walk, how to act, and I've seen many pictures of these girls walking from what's now the administration building to downtown, in white gowns, symbolizing purity.
