So that was the beginning of the Assocration, I guess. (Did you all go in wagons?) Yeah, we went in wason. Everywhere we went at that time. (I guess we'll stop awhile, it's hailing! And when that's ger we'll talk again. Can't hardly hear for that hailing!) (Interruption) (Now we can get started again.) Ben and I used to go to Obtahuchchigee (?) that s Salt Creek to you all. (Who was Ben?) Ben was my husband. And he was a preacher: (Oh.) Uh-huh. And that was his church. And we used to go there and we camped with them. And come on back home. We lost a dog up there, our pet dog. ied about him but he made it back home. From that place to Hanna. (Oh.) We sure was glad of that. And we'd go each Sunday. Fasting time you know, and so we travelled in a wagon. (That fasting you're talking about -- was it at church?) Yeah at (Creek words): Uh-huh. (Oh.) And so--(How long did you all drive back?) Just one day. (Just one day.)

Uh-hum. I guess that was when we went up there. We fast and go and give our testimony. When we got there, there was a lot of people used to come down.
