to go where the water is. They wash that and then they eat it.

(Yeah. No, the days of trapping fur animals I guess is gone. But I guess at one time lots of boys made their loot.)

Made their money. I know us boys did. Why we'd get out and catch a few possums. We'd get a little money, you know. There was a lot of people had tree dogs you know. They'd go out and try that. That's way they'd make a living. They'd catch possum and coons and skunks. Most all of your possums you know will cut the flesh side out. Maskrats you done them that way. But a coon you know, usually you stretched them out in a, whatever you could. Then you put them on boards. Stretched them on the side of the wall. (Yeah.)
