Yeah, they said over here it's part of this restricted area that you can't you know, they put some in there. I don't know how many. You can see watering places in there. They go over there to get water.

(Yeah)

There was another old thing (Not clear) used to use dogs long time ago. I hunt at night too, all the time in the wintertime. I always look forward to wintertime. Time to trap.

(By the way, trapping has become a thing of the past, hasn't it?)

Yeah, they don't trap anymore. I guess anybody traps at all.

(Well, what did you trap in the early days when you were a young fellow?)

I just trap possums and skunks.

(Did you have foxes in this country?)

Yeah, yeah, we've always had foxes. We've caught several of 'em.

You know they like to chase 'em with hounds. Fox hounds get out and have fox races. Twice a week, lots of times.

(There should be coons in this country too.)

Yeah, there's lots of coons in this country now. That's another thing, back them days they just hardly ever caught a coon, or even saw one, but now, there's a bunch of 'em.

(Yeah. What about groundhogs, have they disappeared?)

I haven't seen one in years. Maybe you see one out talking along with dogs or something. But I haven't seen a groundhog in 20 years.

(Been a long time since I've seen one.)

Don't know where they are now. Probably could find one if you get out and look for 'em.
