KIOWA-APACHE INDIAN BORN C. 1892

(Note: This life history material comes from the field notes of W. E. Bittle, Professor of Anthropology, University of Oklahoma. Stewart Klinekole has lived in the vicinity of Boone, Oklahoma most of his life and is still living as of January 18, 1971. In his younger days he war danced and since 1959 he has danced with the reorganized Kiowa-Apache Blackfoot Society. He is the "Whip Man" of the Redbone Blackfoot Group. Stewart's wife, Kate, was the daughter of Old Man Achilta and a half-sister of Rose Chalepah. Kate died about three years ago. J. Jordan.)
