there.

Julius: It's a mile west of Hudson and a mile north.

Mrs. Pennington: And that cemetery is in there between the Swaggerty place and over the hill where Cleve Higgerman lived.

(Cleve lives there now, does he?)

Mrs. Pennington: No, but--

Julius: Old John Morris used to live on the Swaggerty place and John Morris's son did too.

Mrs. Pennington: I don't think there's very many Indians buried there but---(words not clear)

(Yes, 1900 would have been a rough time. that was pretty early in the history of this little area,)

Mrs. Pennington: Well, that's the reason Iknow so much about Centralia.

I was born there in 1900 and I--
(End of Interview)
