(That little camp house sitting, uh-hum,)

Yeah. Women folks was so impressed by our--what the men folks was building that camp house. Some of them women folks over there, they didn't know how to quilt. Ella was showing'em. They couldn't sit down and sew a stitch. Stand up and twist around. Didn't take'em long to learn. Catch on. They went to sewing. They liked it. They made lots of quilts. Sold some of 'em. Give the money to the church. We went building up for a year. I sent Luke over there once or twice, I think, when I was in the hospital. Ella had it tough tho. Toughest part we had, first day--
