new house was built, but I remember where that old original house was.

They used it for a kitchen for a long time. Its entirely gone now.

(Yeah. See, whose original land allotment was this place here where the old man Rogers is buried?)

Har--let me see. Harjos.

(Now you say this was all full of the Musgrove--)

Musgrove. That was the original.

(Musgrove.)

But the allotment, now was Morris.

(Yeah, Morris.)

'Cause it was graveyard was in there way before statehood.

(Oh yeah. It had been there way before statehood, a long time.)

I'm sure Morris' lived here in 1907.

(Yeah.)

This is the allotment right here.

(Interruption)

They held parties just pretty regular around here. Down towards that bank put up Tom Morris house. Tom got his fiddle out. Fiddlin party. (Yeah, those old timers they enjoyed getting together. Dances, meetings of any kind. And their political life was pretty prominent and strong too.)

(Irrelevant conversation)

(Why no. We'll--it won't take but a minute to walk over there and look at it.)

(Irrelevant conversation)

(The old Baptist Mission, I guess, was the center of this community at one time then.)

Evidently was. In every way 'cause it used to--well the cultural center of every town.
