\*Several field workers, including Jordan and Bittle, have made tapes which have not yet been entered on the accession book. The completed collection will number approximately 700 tapes.

One aim of the Project has been to collect at least some oral history materials from all of the tribes now in Okiahoma, with detailed, in-depth materials from a few tribes illustrative of the historical background and present day condition of Okiahoma's several regions of Indian concentration. Within this broad framework field workers have selected their own informants, subject to suggestions from and approval of the Director.

Most of the field workers came to the Project with a background of working with Indian people and already had contacts with members of certain tribes. The general procedure followed by field workers was to explain the aims and nature of the Project to potential Indian informants, and employe in informal conversation subject areas about which the informant might contribute testimony. The resulting tape recorded interviews were
